Ts- bPASS is a website that streamlines and simplifies the process of obtaining building approvals in the State. Since the launch of the online portal in November 2022 to January 2024, GHMC has approved 33,445 new constructions, the highest of all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in Telangana. This achievement signifies Hyderabad's burgeoning urban landscape and highlights the efficiency of the TS-bPASS platform.

The project aims to improve connectivity and facilitate travel for pilgrims and residents of the region. He also announced plans for an outer ring rail project around Hyderabad to decongest major stations.
