Advanced Coastal Research Laboratory for **National Centre for Coastal Research**



Context:

- Union Minister of Earth Sciences Kiren Rijiju inaugurated an advanced Coastal Research **Laboratory of the National Centre for Coastal** Research (NCCR) in Visakhapatnam
- He also laid the foundation stone for various facilities including a collaborative training facility for the NCCR and India Meteorological Department (IMD), research centres and administrative buildings on the NCCR campus at Dolphin's Nose.

Andhra CM inaugurates Rs 500-crore flood retaining wall and riverfront park



Context:

- AP CM inaugurated a significant project in Vijayawada on Tuesday.
- The project comprises two key elements:
- A 2.26-kilometer flood retaining wall was constructed along the Krishna River at Kanaka Durga Varadhi.
- This wall, built at a cost of Rs 500 crore, aims to protect over 80,000 residents of Krishna Lanka from flooding.
- The first phase of a riverfront park, featuring an entry plaza, walking track, open gym, and children's play area.
- This park cost Rs 12.4 crore.

About:

- The CM highlighted the importance of the flood wall in safeguarding lives and criticized the previous government for neglecting construction.
- He also emphasized the recreational benefits of the park for local residents.

No power tariff hike except for railways in Andhra Pradesh

Context:

- AP will see no increase in electricity tariffs for the financial year 2024-25, except for railways.
- This decision was announced by the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (APERC) Chairman.

	 While there's a relief for domestic, agricultural and other categories, the railways will see a hike in energy charges per unit from Rs 5.50 to Rs 6.50. This increase aims to reflect the rising costs and inflation since the last railway tariff revision in 2020-21. The state government played a key role in this by providing a subsidy of Rs 13,589 crore to power distribution companies, which helped avoid a tariff hike for most consumers.
North Andhra Pradesh gets 1st Vande Bharat train	 Context: PM Modi virtually flagged off the first Vande Bharat Express serving North of Andhra Pradesh. The train operates between Visakhapatnam and Bhubaneswar, making stops in Vizianagaram and Srikakulam. This marks the third Vande Bharata train linked to Visakhapatnam, with an existing route to Secunderabad already established.
National Good Samaritan Day	 National Good Samaritan Day is celebrated on March 13th each year. It's a day to recognize people who help others in need, without expecting anything in return. The day is named after the parable of the Good Samaritan in the Bible, which tells the story of a traveler who helps a wounded stranger.


