This project aims to study the gut microbiome of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) in India. The Goal: Unravel the intricacies of microbial genetics within these communities and understand how their unique diet and lifestyle factors influence gut microbiota. The Collaboration: AnSI will leverage its expertise in studying tribal communities to collect samples and data. UoH's DBT-Centre for Microbial Informatics (DBT-CMI) will provide advanced computational biology tools and analysis to generate comprehensive profiles of the gut microbiome. The Impact: This research holds the potential to: Improve our understanding of the relationship between gut health, diet, and traditional practices in these communities. Inform future healthcare interventions and public health initiatives for PVTGs.

About: This scheme launched by the Congress government in Telangana, provides free bus travel for women and transgender individuals across the state. 
