AP government join hands with NIRDPR to boost skill development initiatives in state	 The AP government has partnered with the National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRDPR) to enhance skill development programs in the state. This collaboration aims to make skilling programs more engaging and informative, thereby reducing dropout rates at DDU-GKY training centers. About: The initiative also explores establishing a Center of Excellence (CoE) in collaboration with Singapore's Institute of Technical Education (ITE). This CoE, envisioned as a "plug-and-play" model, would offer dual certification programs and language-specific training aligned with international job requirements.
IIM Vizag to host Atal Incubation Centre	 The Indian Institute of Management Visakhapatnam (IIMV) has been awarded an Atal Incubation Centre (AIC) by NITI Aayog. Only a select few IIMs in the country can boast of having this facility. This is a significant development for the region's startup ecosystem. About: The AIC will provide crucial support services to startups and entrepreneurs, including funding, mentorship, and infrastructure. This will complement IIMV's existing incubation program and further strengthen Visakhapatnam's position as a hub for innovation and entrepreneurship.
Third gender community in the state is under-represented in electoral rolls	 Context: Third gender, including transgenders and eunuchs, is yet to get proper representation in the voters' list of Andhra Pradesh. As per the electoral list figures, it is evident that out of the 4.09 crore voters registered in the electoral list, only 3,346 are in the 'third gender' category. Also, as per the chief electoral officer (CEO)'s constituency-wise elector information, the highest number of 102 third gender voters are in Kakinada town assembly segment in the state, followed by 90
