Context:


- Donuru Ananya Reddy from Telangana's
 Mahbubnagar district achieved a remarkable feat by securing All India Rank (AIR) 3 in the UPSC Civil Services Examination (CSE) 2023.
- This accomplishment makes her the topper among aspirants from both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana (Telugu states).

Singareni solar plants to be completed by August

Context:

- Singareni Collieries Limited (SCCL) is aiming to complete its remaining solar power plants by August 2024
- These plants are part of the first phase of a 300 MW solar power project.
- In February 2024, SCCL finished a 10.5 MW plant, leaving 55.5 MW under construction.
- These plants are spread across Ramagundam, Kothagudem, Chennur areas.
- Once completed, SCCL will be able to generate enough power to meet its own needs and become a net zero energy company.

World Haemophilia Day



Context:

- World Hemophilia Day is observed annually on April
 17th
- It raises awareness about hemophilia and other bleeding disorders.

Key Points:

- Increase understanding: Educate the public about hemophilia, a genetic condition affecting blood clotting.
- Improve diagnosis and care: Advocate for better access to diagnosis and treatment for all, regardless of location or resources
- Support the community: Celebrate the strength and resilience of those living with bleeding disorders.

About:

- World Haemophilia Day was started by the World Federation of Haemophilia in 1989
- April 17 was decided as the date to observe the health day every year to honour the founder of the organization Frank Schnabel, who played a significant

	role in advocating for hemophilia awareness and treatment and dedicated his life towards improving lives of those suffering from the disorder Theme: The theme for this year's World Haemophilia Day is, 'Equitable access for all: recognising all bleeding disorders.' The main idea of this theme is to make sure everyone
	gets treated, no matter what type of bleeding problem they have, how old they are, where they live or their gender.
Public can use DCA's online system for verification of medical shop licenses	The Telangana Drugs Control Administration (DCA) has launched a new system for public use. This system allows anyone to verify if a medical shop or pharmacy has a valid license issued by the DCA. This can help ensure you're purchasing medications from a legitimate source.
IIIT-H, Coursera launch eMSIT	 The International Institute of Information Technology, Hyderabad (IIIT-H) has partnered with Coursera to launch the first-ever online Master of Science in Information Technology (eMSIT) program from an Indian university on the platform. This program integrates industry micro-credentials, allowing students to leverage prior learning and create a personalized learning path. The eMSIT program is designed for individuals aiming to begin or advance their careers in technology. It mirrors the successful on-campus MSIT degree offered by IIIT-H for over two decades. Applications are open now, with the first cohort expected to start in July 2024.
Four Aveksha day care centres launched in city	 The Confederation of Women Entrepreneurs of India (COWE) and the Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) launched four new Aveksha Day Care centers in Hyderabad. These centers provide daycare services for the children of women working in the industrial sector and those from underprivileged communities. The four centers are located in Alkapuri, Santoshnagar, Durganagar, and Suraram. Each center will have a staff of three, including a coordinator, a senior caretaker, and a junior caretaker.
