Over 80 mandals in AP reel under severe heatwave	 Over 80 mandals in Andhra Pradesh are currently facing severe heatwave conditions. Temperatures have soared above 42 degrees Celsius in many areas, causing discomfort and health risks. This heatwave is expected to persist for several days. The districts most affected include East Godavari, Parvathipuram-Manyam, and Kakinada. Authorities have advised residents to stay indoors during peak heat hours and to drink plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration. What is Heatwave? A heat wave, sometimes described as extreme heat, is a period of abnormally hot weather. It is usually measured relative to the usual climate in the area and to normal temperatures for the season. High humidity often accompanies heat waves, especially in oceanic climate countries. In India, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has specific criteria for declaring a heat Wave. It is considered if the maximum temperature of a station reaches at least 40°C or more for Plains, and at least 30°C or more for Hilly regions. If the above criteria are met at least the
	Meteorological sub-division for at least two consecutive days, it is declared a heatwave on the second day.
