Andhra Pradesh government to appoint future skills experts in schools	 Context: The Andhra Pradesh government has announced plans to appoint 2,379 future skills experts in 7,094 government high schools across the state by June 12. This initiative aims to prepare students to compete globally by embracing technology and future opportunities. Key points: Fourth-year engineering students will be chosen for this role to enhance digital teaching in high schools. Regional Joint Directors (RJDs) and District Education Officers (DEOs) will collaborate with college principals for the selection process. Each expert will be assigned to three schools to cultivate academic skills and provide guidance from the academic year 2024-25. Selected experts teaching 8th-grade students will be provided with an e-book containing basic concepts of the three-year engineering course for assessment.
Southwest Monsoon	 Context: The Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) has announced that the Southwest Monsoon is expected to hit the Andaman coast in the next four days. Rains accompanied by thunderstorms expected in some areas of Andhra Pradesh due to influence of surface trough. Monsoon: The seasonal reversal of winds and the associated rainfall of a region.
