	About India Young Professional Scheme:  Conception and Launch: Part of an India-U.K. Migration and Mobility MoU signed in May 2021. Announced at the G20 summit in Bali in November 2021. Formally launched in February 2023. Key Features: Permits up to 3,000 degree-holding citizens aged to live and work in each other's countries for two years. India is the first visa-national country to benefit from this scheme.  Eligibility: Indian citizens aged between 18 and 30 years. Must hold a bachelor's degree or higher. Must have £2,530 in savings. Must not have any children under 18 who live with them or whom they financially support. Must be selected in the India Young Professionals Scheme ballot. Cannot have previously been in the UK under this scheme or the Youth Mobility Scheme visa.
U-WIN portal	Why in the news?  ■ The U-WIN portal, modeled after the Covid-19 vaccine management system Co-WIN, is set to launch nationwide by the end of August.
