



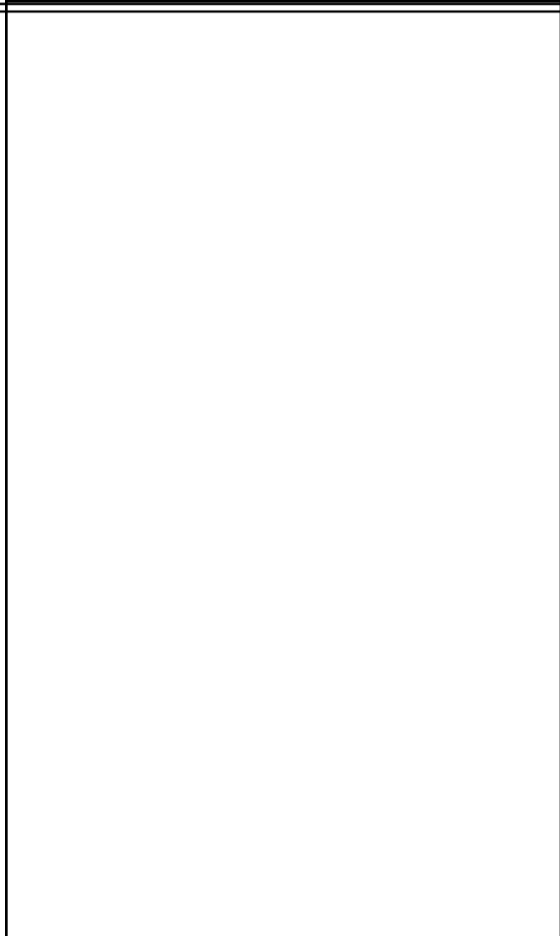

<p>Telangana's Young India Skill University</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TG CM has appointed renowned industrialist Anand Mahindra as the chairman of the newly established Young India Skill University. • This public-private partnership aims to provide world-class skill training to the youth of Telangana. • Mahindra's appointment is seen as a significant step towards transforming the state into a global skill development hub. <p>Telangana Young India Skill University</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Telangana Young India Skill University is a new public-private partnership (PPP) university aimed at providing high-quality skill education and training to the youth of Telangana. • It is established in Mucherla, Rangareddy district. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Focus on Skill Development: The university will offer a range of courses, from short-term certificates to degree and postgraduate programs, designed to equip students with industry-relevant skills. • Public-Private Partnership: The university will be operated through a PPP model, leveraging the strengths of both the government and private sector. • Multiple Campuses: Besides the main campus in Mucherla, additional campuses are planned in Hyderabad, including at the Engineering Staff College of India and the National Academy of Construction. • Job Oriented: The university's curriculum is designed to meet the needs of the industry, providing students with the skills required for employment. • Target Students: The university aims to train 2,000 students in its first year, expanding to 10,000 students in the following year.
<p>Habeas Corpus</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A writ petition was filed under Article 226 of the Constitution in the Telangana High Court,



	<p>seeking a writ of habeas corpus to secure the release of a transgender woman.</p> <p>WRITS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A writ is a formal written order issued by a court, commanding a specific action or prohibiting a certain act. • In India, they are crucial for protecting fundamental rights. • Issued by: Supreme Court (Article 32) and High Courts (Article 226). • Purpose: To enforce fundamental rights and other legal rights <p>Writ Types:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Habeas Corpus: To produce a detained person before the court. • Mandamus: To compel a public official to perform a mandatory duty • Certiorari: To quash an illegal or erroneous order of a lower court. • Prohibition: To prevent a lower court from exceeding its jurisdiction • Quo Warranto: To inquire into the legality of a person holding a public office. <p>Habeas corpus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Habeas corpus is a Latin term meaning "to have the body of". • It is a legal instrument that empowers individuals to seek relief from unlawful detention. <p>Key points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Purpose: To challenge the legality of a person's detention. • Process: The court orders the detaining authority to produce the detained person before it. • The court then examines the grounds for detention • Outcome: If the detention is found to be unlawful, the court orders the immediate release of the individual • Safeguard: It acts as a safeguard against arbitrary arrests and detentions, ensuring that individuals are not held without legal justification.
KITPS	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kothagudem Thermal Power Station (KITPS) in Telangana witnessed a significant event of the



controlled demolition of **eight decommissioned cooling towers**.

- These towering structures, built **between 1966 and 1978, were part of the power plant's older units with a combined capacity of 720 MW**.
- This step marks a significant milestone in the modernization of KTPS, which now boasts a capacity of 1800 MW from its newer units.
- The project is expected to generate revenue of Rs. 485 crore through the sale of scrap from the demolished structures.

Kothagudem Thermal Power Station (KTPS)

- Kothagudem Thermal Power Station (KTPS) is a coal-based power plant located in Palwancha, Telangana, India.
- It is operated by the Telangana State Power Generation Corporation Limited (TSGENCO).

Miyawaki Method



Context:

- Mahesh Talari, a Hyderabad-based environmentalist, is on a mission to increase green cover in the city. He's adopted the Miyawaki method to transform barren plots into lush green spaces.

About Miyawaki Method:

- The Miyawaki method is a rapid afforestation technique **developed by Japanese botanist Akira Miyawaki**.
- It focuses on creating dense, biodiverse forests using native plant species.
- This method involves **planting two to four different types of indigenous trees within every square meter**.
- The methodology was developed in the 1970s

Key principles:

- Native species: Utilizes plants indigenous to the region to ensure ecological balance.

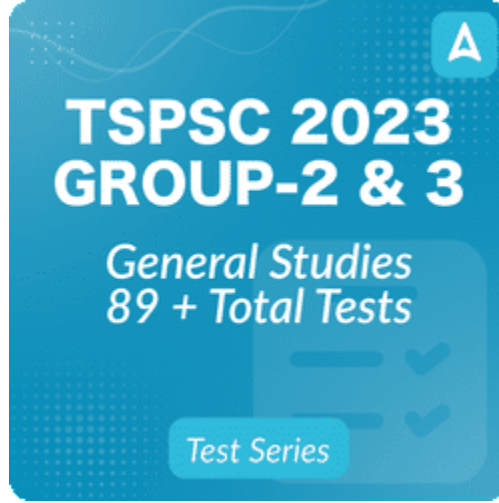
