Places in news: Kursk	<ul> <li>Why in the news?</li> <li>A state of emergency has been declared in Kursk due to a Ukrainian incursion into the Russian border region.</li> <li>About Kursk: <ul> <li>Location: Kursk is a city and administrative centre of Kursk oblast, situated in Russia.</li> <li>Geography: Located in the Black Earth territory, known for its fertile soil.</li> <li>Historical Significance: <ul> <li>Kursk is one of the oldest cities in Russia, first mentioned in documents from 1032.</li> <li>In World War II, Kursk was the site of the Battle of Kursk (July–August 1943), the largest tank battle in history, resulting in a decisive defeat for the Germans.</li> </ul> </li> </ul></li></ul>

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Cround-level ozone	<ul> <li>The virus is part of the same family as the virus that causes smallpox.</li> <li>The first human case was recorded in 1970 in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC).</li> <li>The source of the disease remains unknown, despite its name "monkeypox."</li> <li>Mostly found in Africa but has spread to other regions globally.</li> <li>Why in the news?</li> <li>Ground-level ozone surges in 10 major cities, presents a new urban crisis in India.</li> <li>About Ground-level ozone:         <ul> <li>Ground-level ozone (O<sub>3</sub>) is a harmful air pollutant and a key component of smog.</li> <li>Unlike the protective ozone layer in the upper atmosphere, ground-level ozone is a pollutant at the Earth's surface.</li> <li>Formation:                 <ul> <li>Formation:</li> <li>Ground by chemical reactions between volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>) in the presence of sunlight.</li> <li>Common sources of VOCs and NO<sub>x</sub> include vehicle emissions, industrial facilities, power plants, and chemical solvents.</li> <li>Health Impacts:</li></ul></li></ul></li></ul>
