<p><b>PM marks 5 years of abrogation of Articles 370 and 35(A)</b></p>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prime Minister Narendra Modi recalled the Parliament's 5-year-old decision to abrogate Article 370 and 35(A) that led to a beginning of a new era of progress and prosperity in Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Article 370</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Article 370, was added to the Indian constitution, as a <b>'temporary provision'</b>, on October 17, 1949.</li> <li>It permitted the state of J&amp;K to draft its own Constitution.</li> <li>The Constituent Assembly of Jammu &amp; Kashmir was <b>empowered to recommend which articles of the Indian Constitution</b> should apply to the state.</li> <li>It <b>restricted the Indian Parliament's legislative powers</b> in the state.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Article 35A</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Article 35A stemmed from Article 370 and was <b>introduced through a Presidential Order</b> in 1954, on the recommendation of the J&amp;K Constituent Assembly.</li> <li>It empowered the Jammu &amp; Kashmir legislature to <b>define the permanent residents of the state, and their special rights and privileges.</b></li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Awards in news: Gallantry awards</b></p>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recently, <b>50 armed forces</b> personnel from united Andhra Pradesh have been given gallantry awards.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Gallantry Awards have been instituted by the Government of India <b>to honor the acts of bravery and sacrifice of the officers/personnel</b> of the Armed Forces, other lawfully constituted Forces and civilians.</li> <li>They are announced <b>twice</b> in a year, first on the occasion of the <b>Republic Day</b> and then on the occasion of the <b>Independence Day</b>.</li> <li>There are <b>6 gallantry awards</b> in India.</li> <li>The three gallantry awards namely <b>Maha Vir Chakra, Param Vir Chakra</b> and <b>Vir Chakra</b> were instituted on 26th January 1950 by and later on three gallantry awards <b>Ashoka Chakra, Kirti Chakra</b> and <b>Shaurya Chakra</b> in 1952 were added.</li> </ul>



<p>Rail route between Asansol, Warangal in Telangana</p>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recently, a new railway line project was constructed which will serve as an alternative rail route between Asansol and Warangal.</li> <li>It connects <b>Pandurangapuram (Visakhapatnam), Bhadrachalam (Telangana), and Malkangiri (Odisha).</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The project includes connectivity between Junagarh, Nabarangpur, Jeypore, Malkangiri, Bhadrachalam and Pandurangapuram.</li> <li>It covers a <b>length of 290 route km.</b></li> <li>It provides <b>shorter connectivity to power plants</b> situated in central and south India from Mahanadi coal field areas.</li> <li>This project <b>reduces the carbon footprint</b> of around <b>267 crore kg</b>, which is equivalent to planting 3.80 crore trees.</li> </ul>
<p>“Har Ghar Tiranga 3.0” campaign</p>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Telangana Postal Department has announced the commencement of the sale of National Flags under the “Har Ghar Tiranga 3.0” campaign.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The campaign will start on August 9 and will continue till August 15.</li> <li>The campaign is designed <b>to boost patriotism among citizens</b> as the nation prepares for its Independence Day celebrations.</li> </ul>
<p>Lymphatic filariasis</p>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Telangana Health department has launched a Mass Drug Administration (MDA) programme to fight the <b>high prevalence of filariasis in Sangareddy and Mahabubabad districts.</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lymphatic filariasis, commonly known as <b>elephantiasis</b>, is a <b>neglected tropical disease.</b></li> <li>Infection occurs when <b>filarial parasites</b> are transmitted to humans <b>through mosquitoes.</b></li> <li><b>Cause:</b> It is caused by infection with parasites classified as nematodes (roundworms) of the family Filarioididea.</li> <li>The WHO-recommended <b>preventive chemotherapy strategy</b> for lymphatic filariasis elimination is <b>Mass Drug Administration (MDA).</b></li> </ul>

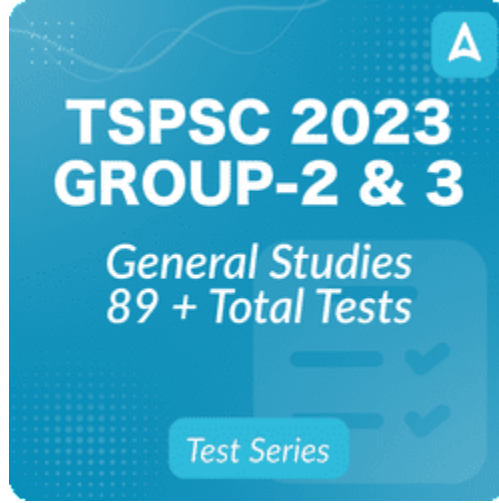
