Krishna Waters Disputes Tribunal	Why in news? ■ The State has requested the Krishna Waters Disputes Tribunal (KWDT -II) to issue orders for utilization of waters in the ratio of 50:50 with effect from the water year 2024-25.
	 Key Points: The origin of the dispute can be traced back to 1956 when Andhra Pradesh was formed by merging the Telugu-speaking regions of Hyderabad State (Telangana) and Madras State (Andhra). In 1969, the Bachawat Tribunal (KWDT-I) was constituted to settle the dispute among Maharashtra, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh over the Krishna water share. The second KWDT was instituted in 2004. It delivered its report in 2010, which made allocations of the Krishna water as follows: 81 TMC for Maharashtra, 177 TMC for Karnataka, and 190 TMC for Andhra Pradesh.

Renewable Energy	Why in news? ■ Brookfield to invest over ₹50,000 cr in renewable energy sector, focusing on wind and solar energy in Andhra Pradesh.
	 Renewable energy is energy derived from natural sources that are replenished at a higher rate than they are consumed. Generating renewable energy creates far lower emissions than burning fossil fuels. Solar Energy Solar energy is the most abundant of all energy resources and can even be harnessed in cloudy weather. Solar technologies convert sunlight into electrical energy either through photovoltaic panels or through mirrors that concentrate solar radiation. Wind Energy Wind energy harnesses the kinetic energy of moving air by using large wind turbines located on land (onshore) or in sea- or freshwater (offshore).
