The Oddiraju brothers also founded Vignana Pracharini Sri Grandhamala in 1919 and produced numerous textbooks.
Dengue	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recently, KTR has expressed concern about the dengue deaths and called for a health emergency in Telangana. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dengue (break-bone fever) is a mosquito-borne viral infection. It is more common in tropical and subtropical climates, mostly in urban and semi-urban areas. It is transmitted to humans through the bite of infected Aedes mosquitos carrying one of four types of dengue virus (DENV). There is no specific medicine to treat dengue. The focus is on treating pain symptoms. The most common symptoms are high fever, headache, body aches, nausea, and rash.

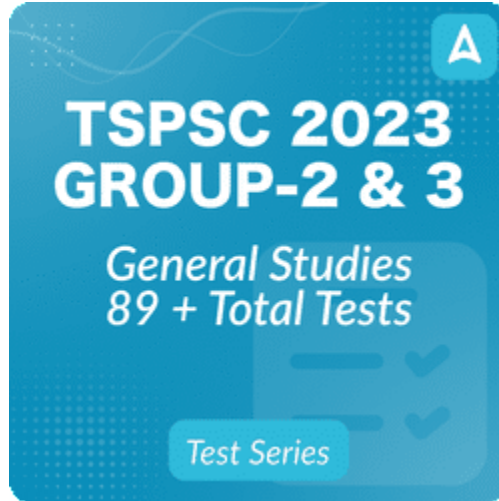
'SPEED' initiative
