Krishna Water Disputes Tribunal (KWDT-II)	Why in news? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Krishna Water Disputes Tribunal (KWDT-II) has finalized 40 draft issues. Key Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In 1969, the Bachawat Tribunal (KWDT-I) was established to settle the water share dispute among Maharashtra, Karnataka, and AP (before bifurcation). The Tribunal allocated 811 tmcft (thousand million cubic feet) of dependable water to AP. The second KWDT was instituted in 2004. The allocations include: 81 TMC for Maharashtra, 177 TMC for Karnataka, and 190 TMC for Andhra Pradesh.
Amaravati - City of Artificial Intelligence (AI)	Why in news? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has directed officials to formulate plans to develop Amaravati as the city of Artificial Intelligence (AI). Key Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> An AI city is a city that uses artificial intelligence (AI) to improve the quality of life for its citizens. The city will have hi-tech infrastructure, incubation for startups, space for AI businesses, and AI-enabled transportation.
MGNREGA	Why in news? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recently, Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu urged everyone to plant at least two saplings annually and nurture them for a greener environment. He highlighted the significance of the Forest and Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Act (MNREGA) departments, and suggested launching additional initiatives such as 'Nagara Vanams' (urban forests) in all Assembly constituencies. Key Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> MGNREGA is the abbreviation for the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act 2005. It is a law passed by the Indian government in 2005 that guarantees the "right to work" to rural citizens of India. The main objective of the MGNREGA is to provide employment to rural citizens and improve their economic conditions.

- Recently, the Andhra Pradesh cabinet has given approval to the implementation of the centrally sponsored scheme 'National e-Vidhan Application' (NEVA) in the state Legislative Assembly.

Key Points:

- National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) is one of the **44 Mission Mode Projects (MMPs)** under the “**Digital India Programme**” of Government of India.
- Aim:** to make the functioning of all the State Legislatures paperless by transforming them into ‘Digital House’.
- It is a **device neutral and member centric application** created to equip them to handle diverse House Business smartly by putting entire information regarding member contact details, rules of procedure, notices, bills, starred/unstarred questions and answers, committee reports etc. in their **hand held devices/ tablets**.
- Nodal Ministry:** Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.

Places in news: Tripurantakam



Why in news?

- Recently, a **second-century common era (CE) period Brahmi inscription** in the Prakrit language was recently discovered near **Tripurantakam village** in Prakasam district.

Key Points:

- Brahmi inscriptions are the **earliest known alphabetical script in India** and are the basis for all modern Indian scripts.
- Additionally, two **15 century Telugu stone inscriptions** were also found within the **Pullalacheruvu mandal** of the district.
