Gruha Jyothi Scheme	 Why in news? Several eligible people were claimed by the beneficiaries to have been left out in the first phase of the Gruha Jyothi scheme, and it has been requested by the government that they re-apply. Key Points: The Gruha Jyothi Scheme is a Telangana government program that provides up to 200 units of free electricity per month to eligible households. Applicants must be Telangana residents, own a white ration card, and have no outstanding electricity bills. Applicants can apply online through the Praja Palana portal by filling out the application form and attaching the required documents.
PM-KUSUM (Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan) Scheme	 Why in news? Governor Jishnu Dev Varma appreciated the Telangana government's support for adopting solar energy for agriculture under PM-KUSUM scheme. Key Points: The PM-KUSUM Scheme was launched in 2019 for de-dieselisation of the farm sector and enhancing the income of farmers. It is aimed at ensuring energy security for farmers in India, along with honoring India's commitment to increase the share of installed capacity of electric power from non-fossil-fuel sources to 40% by 2030 as part of Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs). The scheme aims to add Solar capacity of about 34,800 MW by March 2026 with the total Central Financial support of Rs 34,422 crore. Nodal Ministry: Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE)


