- In order to control the floods, the rivulet was controlled with the **Velagaleru Regulator at Velagaleru village** and a diversion channel named, **Budameru Diversion Channel (BDC)** was constructed from Velagaleru to join Krishna River upstream of Prakasam Barrage.
