#### Context:

• The **20th edition** of the **India - USA** joint military exercise, Yudh Abhyas-2024, began on **9th September 2024**.

#### Key points:

- The exercise is being conducted at the Mahajan Field Firing Ranges in Rajasthan.
- It will take place from 9th to 22nd September 2024, as part of an annual series that alternates between India and the USA since 2004.

#### **Objective of the Exercise:**

- The main goal of Yudh Abhyas 2024 is to **improve joint operational capabilities** for **counter-terrorism** operations in semi-desert conditions.
- The exercise is conducted under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter, focusing on peacekeeping and security operations.

#### Significance of the Joint Exercise:

- Yudh Abhyas provides a platform for both armies to exchange knowledge on tactics, techniques, and operational procedures.
- It strengthens interoperability and fosters camaraderie between the Indian and US military forces.
- The joint exercise is an important step toward **deepening defence cooperation** and further enhancing bilateral relations between the two nations.

#### Context:

• The 2024 Forum on China-Africa Cooperation (FOCAC) summit is held in **Beijing, marking its ninth** edition.

#### Key points:

• The summit, attended by **53 African nations**, marks a crucial phase in **China's relationship with Africa**.













#### China's \$51 Billion Pledge:

- Funding Announcement: At the 2024 FOCAC summit, Chinese President Xi Jinping pledged \$51 billion for 30 infrastructure projects across Africa.
- Financial Assistance: China will offer 360 billion yuan (\$50.7 billion) in financial support.

#### **Evolution of China-Africa Relations:**

- Historical Ties: In the 1950s, China supported African nations in their decolonization efforts, building bilateral trade relationships. This partnership strengthened in the 1970s when African countries supported China's recognition in the UN Security Council.
- First Major Project: The Tanzania-Zambia railway, completed in 1976, marked China's first infrastructure project in Africa.
- **Current Trade:** China became Africa's largest bilateral trading partner in **2009**, with trade reaching \$282 billion in 2023. Africa exports mainly commodities like metals and fuel, while importing manufactured goods from China.

#### China's Role in Africa's Development:

- Belt and Road Initiative (BRI): Africa is a key partner in China's BRI, through which China has invested over \$120 billion in infrastructure development.
- Lending Preferences: African nations are attracted to Chinese funds due to fewer restrictions related to environmental or human rights concerns, unlike loans from institutions like the IMF and World Bank.
- **Geopolitical Influence:** China's approach of non-interference in internal affairs and rejection of human rights politicization appeals to African nations.

#### **Overview of FOCAC:**

- **Established:** FOCAC was founded in **2000** to formalize the strategic partnership between China and African nations.
- **Membership:** It includes **53 African countries**, with Eswatini as the only non-member due to its ties with Taiwan.
- **Summit Frequency:** Held every **three years**, alternating between China and an African nation.
