MSME	 Why in news? The State government accords highest priority to the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) and encourages them to play a crucial role in providing employment opportunities to the youth.
	 Key Points: MSME (Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprise) are regulated under the Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act, 2006. MSMEs are managed under the Ministry of MSME. The current classification is as follows: Micro Enterprises: Investment up to Rs. 1 crore and turnover up to Rs. 5 crores. Small Enterprises: Investment between Rs. 1 crore and Rs. 10 crores, and turnover between Rs. 5 crores. Medium Enterprises: Investment between Rs. 10 crores and Rs. 50 crores, and turnover between Rs. 50 crore and Rs. 250 crores.
Swachhata Hi Seva campaign	 Why in news? The Swachhata Hi Seva campaign will begin on September 17.
	 Key Points: The 'Swachhata Hi Seva' campaign comprises three key pillars: Swachhata Ki Bhagidaari (Public Participation, Awareness, and Advocacy), Sampoorna Swachhata (including Swachhata Lakshit Ekayi), and Safai Mitra Suraksha Shivirs (Preventive Health Checkups and Social Security Coverage). Theme for 2024 - 'Swabhav Swachhata - Sanskar Swachhata'
Ap sets up GoM to examine land allotment in CRDA	 Why in news? The State government has constituted a Group of Ministers (GoM) to examine the issue of land allotment to various institutions in the Capital Region Development Authority (CRDA).
	 Key Points: The GoM will review previous land allotments and decide on the continuation of existing allottees, as well as assess the extent of land previously allotted and consider any necessary changes.

	 It will examine and evaluate new requests for land allotment, identify world-class organizations across various sectors, and provide the necessary support for a significant presence in Amaravati. Additionally, the GoM will monitor the overall progress of land allotment to various institutions in the CRDA as envisaged by the government.
Places in news: Budameru	 Why in news? Budameru breaches have been plugged and flood inflows to Vijayawada were reduced.
	 Key Points: Budameru is a rivulet in NTR district which originates in the hills surrounding Mylavaram and empties itself into Kolleru Lake. Budameru is also known as The Sorrow of Vijayawada. In order to control the floods, the rivulet was controlled with the Velagaleru Regulator at Velagaleru village and a diversion channel named, Budameru Diversion Channel (BDC) was constructed from Velagaleru to join Krishna River upstream of Prakasam Barrage.
Chief Minister Relief Fund	 Why in news? Andhra Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan donated Rs 1 crore to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund for flood relief.
	 Key Points: The Relief amount is being released solely on the basis of the discretionary powers of the Hon'ble Chief Minister. No budgetary allocation is made for the CMRF. The donations made by the general public, Corporate Institutions, Board-Corporations and others constitute the CMRF.
