Tungabhadra Dam



Why in news?

- The high-level expert committee recommended replacing all 33 gates of the Tungabhadra project after one was washed away last month.
- The governments of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, and Telangana are to share the costs and undertake necessary maintenance.

Key Points:

- The Tungabhadra Dam, also known as **Pampa Sagar**, is a water reservoir constructed across the **Tungabhadra River in the Hosapete-Koppal confluence in Karnataka**.
- It is a multipurpose dam serving **irrigation, electricity generation, flood control**, etc. for the state.
- It is **India's largest stone masonry dam** and one of the **only two non-cement dams** in the country, the other being the **Mullaperiyar Dam in Kerala**.

Kaleshwara Mukteswara Swamy Temple

Why in news?

- The master plan for the development of the Kaleshwaram temple and preparations for next year's Saraswati Pushkaralu were discussed.

Key Points:

- Kaleshwara Mukteswara Swamy Temple is a **Hindu temple located in Kaleshwaram, Bhoopalpally, Telangana**.
- It is the **site of a temple of the Hindu god Shiva**.
- The temple is significant because of the **two Shiva Lingas** that are found on a single pedestal. These Linga are named **Lord Shiva and Lord Yama**.
- Kaleshwaram is **one of three Shiva temples mentioned in Trilinga Desham, or "Land of Three Lingas"**.
