Reports & Indices: Asia Power Index	 Why in news? India became the 3rd most powerful nation in Asia, surpassing Japan in the Asia Power Index. Key Points: The Asia Power Index, launched by the Lowy Institute in 2018, is an annual measure of power dynamics in the Asia-Pacific region. It evaluates 27 countries across the Asia-Pacific, examining their ability to shape and respond to the external environment.
National Health Accounts Estimates for India 2020-21 and 2021-22	 Why in news? The Union Health Ministry has released National Health Accounts Estimates for India 2020-21 and 2021-22. Key Points: Total money spent on healthcare in India rose to ₹9.05 lakh crore in FY22 (latest data as per health ministry), a 22% increase compared to ₹7.39 lakh crore in 2020-21, the latest National Health Accounts (NHA) estimates released by the health ministry. Estimates: The decline in Out-of-Pocket expenditure out of Total Health Expenditure from 64.2% in 2013-14 to 39.4% in 2021-22 reflects a very positive indicator. Government Health Expenditure's share in the country's total GDP increases from 1.13% (2014-15) to 1.84% (2021-22). Share of Government Health Expenditure in Total Health Expenditure increases from 29.0% (2014-15) to 48.0% (2021-22) Per capita Government spending on healthcare triples
