Rayalaseema Lift Irrigation Scheme (RLIS)	 Why in news? Andhra Pradesh is proceeding with the construction of the project and recommended the imposition of environmental compensation. Key Points: The Rayalaseema Lift Irrigation Scheme (RLIS) is a project in Andhra Pradesh that aims to provide water to the Rayalaseema region and address drought conditions. The project will divert water from the Srisailam reservoir to the Srisailam right main canal (SRMC). The water will then be fed to various irrigation canals in the four districts of Kadapa, Kurnool, Anantapur, and Chittoor.
Waqf (Amendment) Bill 2024	 Why in news? The YSRC has alleged that the TDP is playing a double game regarding the Waqf Amendment Bill. Key Points: The Waqf (Amendment) Bill 2024 proposes major changes to the Waqf Act 1995, by introducing sweeping changes in the governance and regulation of Waqfs in India. A waqf, also known as habs or mortmain property, is an inalienable charitable endowment established under Islamic law. It is a personal property given by Muslims for a specific purpose- religious, charitable, or for private purposes. The Central Waqf Act, 1954 was enacted after independence to provide for the regulation of Waqfs. This act was ultimately replaced by the Waqf Act, 1995.
Tobacco	 Why in news? The Tobacco Board chief stated that efforts are underway to extend crop coverage to tobacco farmers. Key Points: Tobacco cultivation in India was introduced by the Portuguese in 1605. Tobacco is grown when the mean temperature is 20° to 27°C. When grown as a rainfed crop, it requires at least about 500 mm of well distributed rainfall during crop growing season. It is not usually grown where rainfall exceeds 1200 mm during the season.

	 Key Points: The NTR Aarogyasri scheme in Andhra Pradesh provides free medical treatment up to ₹25 lakh to households with an annual income of up to ₹5 lakh. Households that are eligible for the scheme include: Households with an annual income of up to ₹5 lakh Families who file Income Tax Returns for an annual income of up to ₹5 lakh.
Andhra Pradesh Forms Forum to Enhance Investment and Industry	 Why in news? The Andhra Pradesh government has constituted a 16-member Consultative Forum in partnership with the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) to address issues related to industry, trade, and investment.
	 Key Points: This forum will act as a catalyst for promoting the investment climate, industrial growth, skill development, entrepreneurship, and infrastructure development. The panel will hold consultations, network and establish linkages between various stakeholders in the government and industry. It has been actively serving as a catalyst to promote public and private investments in order to achieve the goal of becoming the preferred global destination by 2050.
