VLF radio waves are used to communicate with submarines that are underwater. The first VLF station was established at INS Kattabomman Radar Station in Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu in 1990.

<p>Person in news: Gummadi Vittal Rao</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka announced that the government will name the film awards after the late balladeer Gaddar. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gummadi Vittal Rao, who was better known as Gaddar, was a poet, singer, and balladeer. He was a prominent figure in the Telangana statehood movement and a fighter for the rights of the poor and oppressed. Gaddar composed and performed several revolutionary songs in Telugu, Hindi, and Gond. He was also known as "praja gayakudu", which means "people's singer".

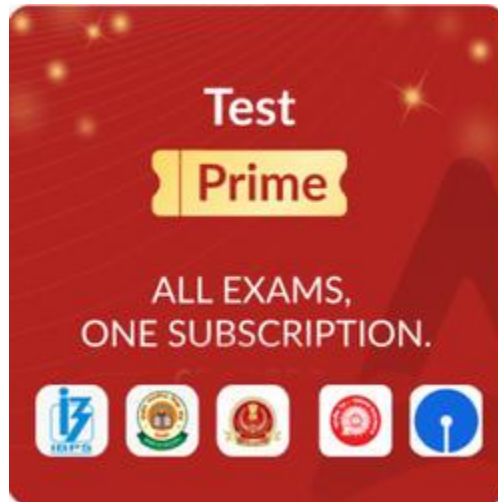

<p>Places in news: Jangaon</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Kannada inscription dating back to the 9th century has been discovered in Jangaon, Telangana. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The inscription was discovered engraved on a stone next to a statue of Lord Ganesha, located on Venkanna rock behind a hillock called Ramulavari Gutta in the village. The text reads: "Sri Sambeya samsara- Bhitam madisidom," suggesting that the sculpture of Lord Ganesha was commissioned by a person named Sambaiah. The language and script of the inscription are characteristic of 9th-century Kannada.
<p>Awards & Honors: Rajiv Gandhi Sadbhavana award</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Veteran Congress leader and former Minister J. Geetha Reddy will be honored with the Rajiv Gandhi Sadbhavana award on the occasion of 34th Rajiv Gandhi Sadbhavana Yatra Commemoration Day. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The award is instituted to remember Rajiv Gandhi, former Prime Minister and former Congress President who hoisted the Congress Party flag and started his Sadbhavana Yatra in twin cities from historic Charminar on October 19, 1990. Rajiv Gandhi National Sadbhavana Award is an Indian award given for outstanding contribution towards promotion of communal harmony, national integration and peace.
