<p><b>Person in news: Komaram Bheem</b></p> 	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Adivasis paid tribute to the tribal legend Komaram Bheem in Telangana.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Komaram Bheem (1901–1940), was a revolutionary leader in Hyderabad State of British India from the Gond tribes.</li> <li>He is also associated with the early part of the movement for Telangana statehood.</li> <li>Bheem, in association with other Gond leaders, led a protracted low intensity rebellion against the feudal Nizams of Hyderabad in the eastern part of the princely state during the 1930s, which contributed to the culmination of the Telangana Rebellion of 1946.</li> </ul>
<p>Musi River</p>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A team of public representatives and bureaucrats, led by Minister for Revenue Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy, will visit Seoul, South Korea to study river rejuvenation efforts related to the revival of the Musi River in Telangana.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It is a river that flows through the southern Indian state of Telangana.</li> <li>It is a tributary of the Krishna River in the Deccan Plateau.</li> <li>It was known as the Muchukunda River in earlier</li> </ul>

<b>Kawal Tiger Reserve</b>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Telangana forest department has submitted the final proposal to the state govt for declaration of the Kawal tiger corridor as a conservation reserve.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It is located in the north-eastern part of Telangana (Old Adilabad district), with the Godavari River on one side and the Maharashtra border on the other.</li> <li>It forms part of the Deccan peninsula-central highlands.</li> <li>Rivers: The reserve is the catchment for the rivers Godavari and Kadam, which flow towards the south of the sanctuary.</li> <li>Geographically, the reserve is situated at the southernmost tip of the Central Indian Tiger Landscape, having linkages with the Tadoba-Andhari (Maharashtra) and Indravati (Chhattisgarh) tiger reserves.</li> </ul>
<b>Drone Survey</b>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A drone survey began for designing a digital master plan for the development of Vikarabad.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Vikarabad is one of 20 municipalities in Telangana with a population exceeding 50,000 selected for a Geographical Information System (GIS)-based master plan.</li> <li>This initiative is part of the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0, under the Union Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs.</li> <li>The project is partially funded by the Central government.</li> <li>The survey is being conducted by Vikarabad district authorities in collaboration with officials from the Survey of India.</li> </ul>

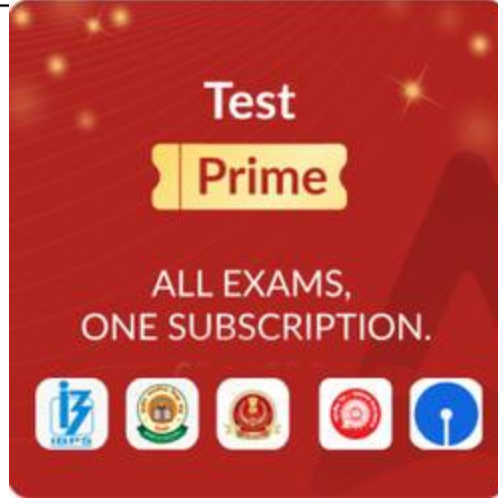
