Krishna River Management Board (KRMB)	 Why in news? The Andhra Pradesh water users' body has urged the Krishna River Management Board (KRMB) to release water from the Nagarjuna Sagar Left Canal (NSLC). Key Points: The Krishna River Management Board (KRMB) is an autonomous body established as per AP Reorganization Act, 2014 under the administrative control of MoWR to manage and regulate the Waters of Krishna Basin in the states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. It comprises the Union Jal Shakti Minister and the Chief Ministers of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.
Kaleshwaram lift irrigation project	The Ghose panel on Kaleshwaram has summoned the former Engineer-in-Chief (ENC) again, instructing him to present relevant documents during the session. Key Points:
	 Location: KLIP is a multipurpose irrigation project on the Godavari River i.e, at Kaleshwaram village in Telangana. The Pranhita-Godavari river confluence is the location of KLIP. It is claimed to be the world's largest multi-stage and multi-purpose lift irrigation project. A key feature of the KLIP is a series of underground and surface water pumping stations, which are said to be the world's largest such structures.
Paddy crop	Why in news? ■ Telangana is poised to achieve its highest-ever paddy yield this year, with an estimated production of 150 lakh metric tonnes (LMTs).
	 Key Points: Paddy is a Kharif crop that requires warm, wet climates with high temperatures (above 25°C) and high humidity. It needs annual rainfall of over 100 cm, but in areas with less rainfall, irrigation can be used. Paddy is grown in the plains of north and northeast India, coastal areas, and deltaic regions.
Rythu Bharosa scheme	 Why in news? Farmers staged a protest demanding that the State Government extend assistance under the Rythu Bharosa scheme.

- The Rythu Bharosa scheme in Telangana is an initiative to **provide** financial assistance to landholding farmer families.
- Annual payment: A payment of ₹13,500 per year per family, subject to exclusions
- Eligibility: Families cultivating ROFR lands, D Patta lands, or acquired lands for which compensation was not paid are eligible




