

ATR covers a part of the Nallamala Forest, which is part of the Eastern Ghats chain. It is the second-largest Tiger Reserve in terms of core area. Major reservoirs like the Srisailam Dam and Nagarjuna Sagar Dam are fed by the river Krishnaand its several perennial streams that originate in the ATR. The Chenchu tribe is one of the major tribal communities that live in the ATR.






