- The Gussadi dance is a courtship ritual in the matriarchal society of the Raj Gond tribes where the dance tries to impress the prospective bride and her family.

 In the 115th episode of 'Mann Ki Baat', Prime Minister Narendra Modi praised city-based folk artist D. Vaikuntam for his contributions to Cheriyal Nakashi art and his efforts to preserve India's cultural heritage.

Key Points:

- Cheriyal art is a traditional art form that originated in the village of Cherial in Telangana.
- It is a type of visual storytelling that depicts stories from Indian mythology, folk traditions, and rural life.
- Cheriyal art often depicts mythological epics like the Ramayana and Mahabharata, as well as folk stories and ballads from communities like Gauda and Madiga.

PHCs

Why in news?

 The Health & Family Welfare Department is actively considering renaming Primary Health Centres (PHCs) as Aarogya Mandirs.

Key Points:

- PHCs are the cornerstone of rural health services- a first port of call to a qualified doctor of the public sector in rural areas for the sick and those who directly report or are referred from Sub-Centres for curative, preventive and promotive health care.
- The Bhore Committee in 1946 gave the concept of PHC as a basic health unit to provide as close to the people as possible, an integrated curative and preventive health care to the rural population with emphasis on preventive and promotive aspects of health care.
- Examples of primary health care services include routine check-ups, immunizations, screening tests, chronic disease


