	 Key Points: It is an ongoing Indian Railways mission launched in February 2023 by the Ministry of Railway to redevelop railway stations across India. It is designed for the ongoing development of railway stations with a long-term perspective. It involves the creation of master plans and their phased implementation to improve various aspects of station facilities. The scheme aims to transform railway stations into modern, well-equipped hubs with improved passenger amenities, better traffic circulation, inter-modal integration, and enhanced signage.

Key Points: The e-National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) is a pan-India electronic trading platform that connects agricultural markets across the country. It was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on April 14, 2016, to create a unified national market for agricultural commodities. The Small Farmers Agribusiness Consortium (SFAC) is the lead agency for implementing e-NAM.
Folk art	 Why in news? Rayalaseema's folk arts are unique cultural treasures. Key Points: Folk art refers to traditional and indigenous forms of artistic expression that are deeply rooted in the culture, customs, and heritage of a specific community or region. Folk arts in Rayalaseema, including Kolatam, Chekka Bhajana, Jatijamu, Tholubommalata, Yakshagana, and Pagati Veshalu, have developed from daily life, mirroring social customs and emotions, while excluding aggressive tones such as 'Roudram' and 'Bibhatsa.' "Jati Jamu" is a form performed by women, especially during Sankranti, where young women gather around decorated gobbemmalu, singing songs that celebrate social and historical themes to honor their communal heritage.
