It is based on a community approach to water and will include extensive Information, Education and communication as a key component of the mission. Nodal Ministry: Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation under the Jal Shakti Mantralaya. Funding Pattern: 50:50 between Centre and States 90:10 for Himalayan and North-Eastern States. In case of UTs, 100% funding is provided by the Central government.
Polavaram Project	 Why in news? Water Resources Minister Nimmala Rama Naidu has made it clear that the State government will not compromise on the 45.72 metre height of the Polavaram Irrigation Project.
	 Key Points: It is an under-construction multi-purpose irrigation project on the Godavari River in the Eluru District and East Godavari District in Andhra Pradesh. The project has been accorded National project status by the Union Government of India. Objectives:
