Why in news?

 The Telangana government has approved the Master Plan-2041 for the Kakatiya (Warangal) Development Area, as per the Government Order (G.O.) Ms. No. 202 issued by the Municipal Administration and Urban Development (MA&UD) Department.

Key Points:

- The plan covers an area of 1,805 sq. km across 181 revenue villages.
- Its objective is to guide the urban development of Warangal and its surrounding areas for the next 20 years.
- The Master Plan was prepared by the Kakatiya Urban Development Authority (KUDA).
- The plan includes land use zoning and regulations to promote general development.
- Public consultations were held, with inputs from technical review committees and district officials.
- The draft plan was notified in 2018, inviting public objections and suggestions for a 90-day period.

Kaleshwaram lift irrigation project

Why in news?

 Telangana achieves record paddy harvest without using Kaleshwaram water.

Key Points:

- **Location:** KLIP is a multipurpose irrigation project on the Godavari River i.e, at Kaleshwaram village in Telangana.
- The Pranhita-Godavari river confluence is the location of KLIP.
- The Wardha, Painganga, and Wainganga rivers, which together make up the seventh-largest drainage basin on the subcontinent, come together at the confluence of the Pranahita River.
- It is claimed to be the world's largest multi-stage and multi-purpose lift irrigation project.

Article 338 of the Indian Constitution deals with NCSC. It was established with a view to provide safeguards against the exploitation of Scheduled Castes and Anglo-Indian communities to promote and protect their social, educational, economic, and cultural interests; special provisions were made in the Constitution. National Human Rights Commission (NHRC): NHRC was established under the Protection of Human Rights Act (PHRA), 1993. It is an embodiment of India's concern for the promotion and protection of human rights. It is established in conformity with the Paris Principles (1991), adopted at the first international workshop on national institutions for the protection of human rights.

Key Points: The Telangana Pollution Control Board (TGPCB) is a ministry of Government of Telangana. It operates under the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of the State of Telangana, India. The board is tasked with enforcing laws related to environmental protection. TGPCB was established under Section 4 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 5 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981. Discuss:

Government Borrowings

Why in news?


The Telangana government seems to be proceeding cautiously with increasing market borrowings through the auction of state government securities by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

Key Points:

- Borrowing is a loan taken by the government and falls under capital receipts in the Budget document.
- Usually, the Government borrows through the issue of government securities called G-secs and Treasury Bills.
- If the government resorts to larger borrowings, more than what it has projected, then its interest costs also go up risking higher fiscal deficit. That hurts the government's finances.
- Larger borrowing programme means that the public debt will go up and especially at a time when the GDP growth is subdued, it will lead to a higher debt-to-GDP ratio
