Telangana's EV policy	Why in news? ■ Telangana's newly unveiled electric vehicle (EV) policy has turned out to be a boon for vehicle buyers as it provides tax exemptions ranging between 1.4 lakh and 45 lakh on new

	electric vehicles, with premium cars receiving the maximum benefits. It aims to promote the use of electric vehicles in Telangana in a bid to control air pollution, especially in and around Hyderabad. Key Points: Key features of Telangana's EV policy: The government has announced with immediate effect a 100 per cent exemption from road tax and registration fee on EVs for two years, till December 31, 2016. A previous limit on tax exemptions for the first 5000 EVs has been lifted and, as per the new policy, there is no limit to the number of EVs that can be registered with the tax exemptions. The tax exemptions will apply to two-wheelers, four-wheelers, commercial passenger vehicles like taxis and tourist cabs, three-seater auto-rickshaws, electric tractors, and electric buses. With these exemptions, two-wheelers can save up to Rs 15,000 and four-wheelers can save up to Rs 3 lakh in taxes and fees. Electric buses operated by companies or firms to ferry their employees are also exempt from the taxes.
Core Cold Wave Zones	Why in news?
	 Telangana is one of the 17 states and UTs included in the 'Core Cold Wave Zone'.
	Key Points:
	 The Core Cold Wave Zone in India is a region that experiences frequent and severe cold waves during the winter season. The states and union territories in the Core Cold Wave
	 Zone are: Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Ladakh, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Telangana, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, and West Bengal. The India Meteorological Department (IMD) defines cold wave conditions as temperatures that fall below average for an extended period of time. In plains, the minimum temperature must be less than or equal to 10°C, and in hilly regions it must be less than or equal to 0°C.



- It is a specialized body set up under the National Green Tribunal Act (2010) for effective and expeditious disposal of cases relating to environmental protection and conservation of forests and other natural resources.
- With the establishment of the NGT, India became the third country in the world to set up a specialized environmental tribunal, only after Australia and New Zealand, and the first developing country to do so.
- NGT is mandated to make disposal of applications or appeals finally within 6 months of filing the same.
- The NGT has five places of sittings, New Delhi is the Principal place of sitting and Bhopal, Pune, Kolkata and Chennai are the other four.
