	 Mandal means such area in a district as may be declared by the Government by notification to be a Mandal under section 3 of the Telangana Districts (Formation) Act, 1974, excluding the areas covered under the Telangana Municipalities Act, 1965 and the Municipal Corporations. With a population of around 40,000, the decision to make Bhadrachalam a mandal is expected to pave the way for elections.
High Court Judge	Why in news? ■ Union Law Minister states that there are fifteen vacant judge positions in the Telangana High Court.
	 Key Points: The judges of a high court are appointed by the President of India. The Chief justice of a high court is appointed after consultation with the CJI and governor of the state concerned. If it is for a common high court, then the governors of all the concerned state high court are consulted In case of appointment of other judges to high court, it was








