Record of Rights Bill, 2024	Why in news?  • The Telangana government is set to introduce the RoR Bill in the Assembly.
	<ul> <li>Key Points:</li> <li>The Telangana Record of Rights Bill, 2024 is a bill that was introduced in the Telangana Assembly.</li> <li>The bill repeals the Telangana Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Books Act, 2020.</li> <li>The bill also includes provisions for the government to make rules, and for the State Legislature to modify or annul those rules.</li> <li>The Record of Rights (RoR) is a legal document that contains information about a land parcel, including: <ul> <li>ownership, land use, tenancy, boundaries, type of land, encumbrances, cultivation, and property taxation.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The RoR is also known as the Jamabandi in many states across India.</li> </ul>

National Dam Safety Authority (NDSA)	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>The National Dam Safety Authority (NDSA) could not submit its final report on the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Scheme due to the state government's failure to provide the required information, said Vedire Sriram, adviser to the Ministry of Jal Shakti.</li> <li>Key Points:         <ul> <li>Water is under the state list, but the Union government has made Dam safety law under Article 246 of the Constitution.</li> <li>Article 246 empowers Parliament to legislate on matters listed in the state list under certain conditions.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The Dam Safety Act, passed by Parliament, provides an institutional mechanism for ensuring dam safety in India.</li> <li>The Act established a National Dam Safety Authority to maintain standards related to dam safety, prevent dam-related disasters and address inter-State concerns related to dams.</li> <li>The act also has penal provisions, list of offenses and penalties, for ensuring compliance of the Act.</li> </ul>
Swadesh Darshan 2.0 Scheme	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>The Telangana Tourism Development Corporation (TGTDC), in partnership with the Ministry of Tourism under the Swadesh Darshan 2.0 scheme, has announced plans to develop Ananthagiri Hills in Vikarabad district as an ecotourism zone (ETZ).</li> <li>The ETZ will offer a range of nature-based activities such as trekking, birdwatching, and nature walks for tourists.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Key Points:         <ul> <li>The Ministry of Tourism has revamped its Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) for development of sustainable and responsible tourist destinations covering tourism and allied infrastructure, tourism services, human capital development, destination management and promotion backed by policy and institutional reforms.</li> <li>The objective for the Swadesh Darshan 2.0 scheme envisages increase in private sector investment in tourism &amp; hospitality.</li> <li>It may help in increasing Public Private Partnerships (PPP) in the field of tourism and operation and maintenance of the created assets under the scheme.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>


