GI Tag	 Why in news? The renowned Warangal Chapata Chilli, also known as the "tomato chilli", is all set to receive the Geographical Indication (GI) tag from the Union government. This chilli is known for its bright red, bold and thick-walled cultivars. It is called "Tomato chilli" due to its blocky, tomato-like appearance. Key Points: A Geographical Indication (GI tag) is a sign used on products with a specific geographical origin, possessing unique qualities or reputation due to that origin. It serves as an intellectual property right (IPR), attributing a product's quality, reputation, or other characteristic to its geographical origin. Type of products: Geographical indications can be used for a wide range of products, including agricultural products, foodstuffs, wines, spirits, handicrafts, and industrial products. 				
Dengue	 Why in news? According to data from the National Centre for Vector Borne Diseases Control (NCVBDC), the State reported more than 3,000 cases in just September and October. 				
	 Key Points: Dengue (break-bone fever) is a mosquito-borne viral infection. It is more common in tropical and subtropical climates, mostly in urban and semi-urban areas. Transmission: It is transmitted to humans through the bite of infected Aedes mosquitos carrying one of four types of dengue virus (DENV). Dengue isn't contagious from person to person except when passed from a pregnant person to their child. Symptoms: The most common symptoms are high fever, headache, body aches, nausea, and rash. Most will get better in 1–2 weeks. Treatment: There is no specific medicine to treat dengue. The focus is on treating pain symptoms.

- Functions:
 - It provides real-time insights into terminal, landside, and airside operations.
 - It can identify disruptions and ensure a balance between airport demand and capacity.
 - It can help reduce the time passengers spend in check-in and security queues.
 - It can help optimize resource utilization and streamline processes.
 - It can help maintain safety standards by monitoring aircraft movements and bird activity.




