- Diabetes is a chronic disease that occurs when the pancreas can no longer make insulin, or the body cannot make good use of the insulin it produces.
- Insulin is a hormone that regulates blood glucose.
- Not being able to produce or use insulin effectively leads to raised glucose levels in the blood, known as hyperglycaemia.
- India has the second-highest number of diabetes patients in the world, after China.
- **Government of India's Initiatives:**
 - The National Diabetes Policy, which was launched in 2017, aims to reduce the prevalence of this disease in India by 20% by 2025.
 - The Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY), also known as Ayushman Bharat, is a national health insurance scheme that provides free coverage for treatment to over 500 million people.
 - The Health Department is starting a new initiative called the NCD Control program to screen the entire population for non-communicable diseases (NCDs) and their risk factors.

Finance State Commission (SFC)

Why in news?

A request has been made for the intervention of the Telangana Governor to release the recommendations of the State Finance Commission and the actions taken on them.

Key Points:

- The State Finance Commission (SFC) is a unique institution created by the 73rd and 74th Constitutional Amendments (CAs).
- It was primarily to rectify growing horizontal imbalances in essential public services delivery.
- Article 243I of the Constitution mandated the State Governor to constitute a Finance Commission.
- Status The SFC is undoubtedly modelled on the UFC (Union Finance Commission) created under Article 280.
 - The UFC is tasked with rectifying vertical and horizontal imbalances at the Union-State level.
 - The SFC has to perform the same with reference to State/sub-State-level institutions.
 - Role SFCs have to promote minimum essential services in rural and urban areas.




