One Nation One Number (ONON) system	 Why in news? Hyderabad-based GIS professionals have proposed a coordinate-based door numbering system under the "One Nation One Number" initiative. 		
	 Key Points: The idea which leverages satellite imagery and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) tools to assign a precise digital address to each property can also be self-generated by the property owners limiting the manual work load and human intervention. This digital-based numbering system is designed to assign a unique and unrepeatable coordinate-based number to each property which provides a scientific-based solution to the often faulty or repetitive door numbers that currently exist in the State. 		
Clathrus delicatus	 Why in news? A rare Clathrus delicatus, commonly known as shuttlecock mushroom, has been discovered in Telangana's Kawal Tiger Reserve. 		
	 About: Clathrus delicatus is a species of fungus in the stinkhorn family. It originates from Sri Lanka and India. Clathrus delicatus was previously believed to be restricted to the Western Ghats spread in Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka and the western regions of the Indian subcontinent. 		
	 Key Points: It is located in the north-eastern part of Telangana State along the banks of the river Godavari, forming part of the Deccan Peninsula-central highlands. Spanning over 2015 sq. km, the reserve is nestled in the Sahyadri Mountain Ranges. The government of India declared Kawal Wildlife Sanctuary a Tiger Reserve in 2012. It has a diverse habitat comprising dense forests, grasslands, open areas, rivers, streams, and water bodies. Rivers: The reserve is the catchment for the rivers Godavari and Kadam, which flow towards the south of the sanctuary.

- The new Act has provision for creation of Bhudhar, record for all land parcels across the State and issuance of Bhudhaar cards for protecting the ownership rights as well as ensuring access to the land details with a click of mouse.
- This bill aims to amend the existing Record of Rights (RoR act) Act, replacing the outdated Dharani portal with the innovative Bhumata portal as an online platform to improve land registration process.
- Bhudhaar" means the land parcel unique identification number assigned to any parcel of land, as contained in the Record of Rights, in such manner as may be prescribed which includes
 - "Temporary Bhudhaar" a Bhudhaar assigned to indicate that the Geo-referencing of the parcel of land or lands appurtenant to the property has not been completed.
 - "Permanent Bhudhaar" a Bhudhaar assigned to indicate that the Geo-referencing of the parcel of land or lands appurtenant to the property has been completed.
- Bhudhaar Card" means a document prepared or generated and maintained in an electronic form in such format as may be prescribed describing a parcel or parcels of land as contained in the Record of Rights, and specifying the Bhudhaar Number or Numbers assigned to such parcel or parcels
