Revanth Reddy on Telangana Formation Day, June 2, 2025. Key Points: On 2nd June, 2014 the northwestern part of Andhra Pradesh was separated and 29th state Telangana was created. Telangana celebrates its Formation Day to mark the people's contribution to form a separate state outside of Andhra Pradesh. The Andhra State Act (1953) formed the first linguistic state of India, known as the state of Andhra, by taking out the Telugu speaking areas from the State of Madras (now Tamil Nadu). The States Reorganisation Act (1956) merged the Telugu-speaking areas of Hyderabad state with the Andhra state to create the enlarged Andhra Pradesh state. The Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act (2014) bifurcated
	Andhra Pradesh into two separate states, namely, the Andhra Pradesh (residuary) and the Telangana.
Bill to establish Sports University in Telangana	 Why in news? A bill to establish a sports university in Telangana was tabled in the assembly. Decks are being cleared for the establishment of Young India Physical Education and Sports University (YIPE&SU) in Telangana.
	 Key Points: According to the bill, the university will play an important role in developing world-class professionals in sports science, coaching, management and medicine that will contribute to both education and high performance athletics. The university will aim to nurture elite athletes, support research and sports-related economic growth to position Telangana as a leader in the country's sports sector. It will support innovation, sports-related industries and promote fitness and health among the wider population.

Bhu Bharati (Record of Rights) Act

Why in news?

The Telangana government has introduced the new Telangana Bhu Bharati (Record of Rights) Act in the Assembly.

Key Points:

- The new Act has provision for creation of Bhudhar, record for all land parcels across the State and issuance of Bhudhaar cards for protecting the ownership rights as well as ensuring access to the land details with a click of mouse.
- This bill aims to amend the existing Record of Rights (RoR act) Act, replacing the outdated Dharani portal with the innovative Bhumata portal as an online platform to improve land registration process.
- **Key Provisions of the Bill:**
 - The Bill has provisions to establish tribunals, appellate and revisional authority.
 - The Bill also has provisions for village level revenue officers and manually storing the revenue records.
 - The Bill also empowers revenue mandal, district officers - MROs and RDOs - to address the grievances.






