| Andhra Government launches green skilling program | Why in news? The State government has launched India's largest green skilling initiative to create employment opportunities for youth in the renewable energy sector. The programme, spearheaded by the Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC), aims to generate 7.5 lakh jobs and position the State as a global hub for green talent. |

| | Two MoUs were signed with Suzlon Energy and Swaniti Initiative to enhance skills for the renewable energy sector. |
| | The first MoU with Suzlon Energy focuses on training 12,000 individuals in mechanical, electrical, blade technology, civil, and licensing fields. Suzlon will also set up five skill labs in selected ITIs and polytechnic colleges. The skill labs, offering vocational courses of 3 to 12 months, aim to meet the demand for skilled professionals in the renewable energy sector. The second MoU with Swaniti Initiative focuses on assessing the skill landscape and mapping job opportunities in renewable energy across five districts. Swaniti will develop a renewable energy skill strategy within four months and implement it over the next two years. |

| | Key Points: Organic farming is a method of agriculture that avoids synthetic substances like pesticides, fertilizers, and genetically modified organisms (GMOs). Organic farming is based on natural processes and resources, and aims to produce healthier food while protecting the environment. The key components of this action plan include: |

| NTR Vaidya Seva scheme | Why in news? The Andhra Pradesh government has announced the release of ₹500 crore for the Dr. NTR Vaidya Seva scheme. Key Points: The Dr. Nandamuri Taraka Rama Rao Vaidya Seva scheme is a health insurance program in Andhra Pradesh that provides financial assistance to the poor. The scheme provides up to ₹25 lakhs in coverage per family per year. Eligibility BPL families identified by the Civil Supplies Department are eligible. People with a photo and name on a BPL ration card and suffering from certain diseases are also eligible. The scheme offers free medical tests in government hospitals, free follow-up medicines for 138 procedures, and a postoperative sustenance allowance. |
