AP High Court Judges

Why in news?

 The Supreme Court Collegium recently sanctioned the elevation of two judicial officers, Avadhanam Hari Haranadha Sarma and Dr. Yadavalli Lakshmana Rao, as judges of the Andhra Pradesh High Court.

Key Points:

- The judges of a high court are appointed by the President of India.
- The Chief justice of a high court is appointed after consultation with the CJI and governor of the state concerned.
- If it is for a common high court, then the governors of all the concerned state high court are consulted
- In case of appointment of other judges to high court, it was opined that CJI should consult a collegium of two senior-most judges of the SC before recommending a name to the President of India in the seminal third judges case.

Solar Project



Why in news?

- Reliance NU Suntech, a subsidiary of Reliance Power, plans to invest Rs 10,000 crore in a solar power project in Kurnool district on a build-own-operate basis.
- The project consisting of a 930 MW solar energy contract with 465 MW/1,860 MWh battery energy storage system (BESS) component, is Asia's largest solar and battery energy storage project.

Key Points:

- Solar power, also known as solar electricity, is the conversion of energy from sunlight into electricity, either directly using photovoltaics (PV) or indirectly using concentrated solar power.
- Solar panels use the photovoltaic effect to convert light into an electric current.

Cockfighting



Why in news?

• Betting on rooster fights has crossed Rs 2000 crore during the Sankranti festivities.

Key Points:

- A cockfight is a blood sport, held in a ring called a cockpit.
- Cockfighting in India primarily takes place in January,

coinciding with Makar Sankranti.

•	The practice is widespread in coastal districts of Andhra
	Pradesh, including Krishna, Guntur, East Godavari and
	West Godavari districts, despite being illegal in India.

- Roosters are specially bred for cockfights, with knives and blades tied to their legs. The fight typically results in the death of one of the birds.
- In January 2018, the Supreme Court allowed the sport to be held in a traditional way, without the use of knives and blades and without gambling or betting.

Why in news?

- The Sankranti festive season has led to a surge in tourist visits to Kondaveedu Fort in Palnadu district, with daily footfall increasing from 100-200 to 4,000-4,500 visitors between January 11 and 15.
- Originally built by the Reddy Kings during the 13th and 14th centuries, the fort stands as a testament to their glory.
- The fort, perched on a hill and surrounded by defensive banks and ditches, features 23 towers, three temples, and a mosque.

Key Points:

- The Uppalapadu Bird Sanctuary is located in Uppalapadu, near Guntur City.
- Painted storks, spot-billed pelicans and other birds that migrate from various countries such as Siberia and Australia use the village water tanks for nesting.

Polavaram Project

Why in news?

The Union Jal Sakthi Parliamentary Standing Committee (2024-25), led by its Chairperson Rajiv Pratap Rudy, arrived at the Polavaram project site on Saturday to review the progress of the irrigation project.

Key Points:

- It is an under-construction multi-purpose irrigation project on the Godavari River in the Eluru District and East Godavari District in Andhra Pradesh.
- The project has been accorded National project status by the Union Government of India.
- **Objectives:**
 - Development of Irrigation, Hydropower and drinking water facilities in East Godavari, Visakhapatnam, West Godavari and Krishna districts of Andhra Pradesh.
 - The project envisages the generation of 960 MW of hydropower, drinking water supply to a population of 28.50 lacks in 611 villages
 - The ultimate irrigation potential of the project is 4.368
