<p>Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project (KLIP)</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Justice Ghose panel is set to begin the final phase of evidence collection for the KLIP barrages and aims to submit its report to the government before its term ends on February 28. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Location: KLIP is a multipurpose irrigation project on the Godavari River i.e, at Kaleshwaram village in Telangana. The Pranhita-Godavari river confluence is the location of KLIP. It is claimed to be the world's largest multi-stage and multi-purpose lift irrigation project. A key feature of the KLIP is a series of underground and surface water pumping stations, which are said to be the world's largest such structures.
<p>Reports & Indices: Annual Status of Education Report (ASER)</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to the Annual Status of Education Report (ASER) 2023 'Beyond Basics', Telangana has a significant issue, with 30.1% of its population in the 14-18 age group being outside the schooling system. This figure is more than double the national average of 13.2% for the same age group not being enrolled in school. The data for Telangana is based on a survey conducted in 59 villages in Khammam district, which accounts for 7.6% of the state's population. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ASERs (by NGO Pratham) have been surveying children aged 6 to 14 since 2005 to track trends in school enrollment, attendance and reading and arithmetic abilities. ASER reports are usually referred to by the government while formulating policies. The youths were surveyed on 4 points – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Basic reading, math and English abilities; Application of basic skills to everyday calculations; Reading and understanding written instructions; and Financial calculations that need to be done in real life.
<p>Sri Kaleshwara Sri Mukteshwara Swamy temple</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The historic Sri Kaleshwara Sri Mukteshwara Swamy temple in Kaleshwaram will host the Maha Kumbabishekam on a grand scale from February 7 to 9, 2025.

These Lingas are named Lord Shiva and Lord Yama. Together, they are referred to as Kaleshwara Mukteeshwara Swamy. • Kaleshwaram is one of the three prominent Shiva temples mentioned in Trilinga Desham, meaning "Land of Three Lingas."

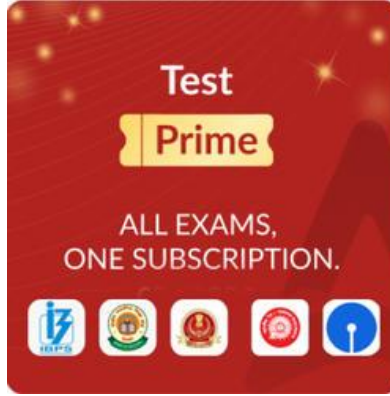
