Etikoppaka Toys



Why in news?

- As part of the 76th Republic Day parade held at Kartavya Path in New Delhi, the Andhra Pradesh tableau was honoured with a jury award by the Central government.
- The Andhra Pradesh's tableau captivated the audience with its vibrant portrayal of the famous Etikoppaka toys, highlighting the State's rich cultural heritage and eco-friendly craftsmanship.
- The tableau showcased an artisan making the traditional wooden toys, accompanied by intricately crafted pieces, including Lord Venkateswara idols.

Key Points:

- Located on the banks of the river Varaha in Visakhapatnam district of AP, is a small village called Etikoppaka.
- Made in the Etikoppaka region of Andhra Pradesh, these toys are made with lacquer color and are traditionally known as Etikoppaka toys or Etikoppaka Bommalu.
- The toys are also called lacquer toys because of the application of lacquer coating.
- These are well known for canon toys, lord Ganesha form and bullock etc.
- The toys are made out of wood and are coloured with natural dyes derived from seeds, lacquer, bark, roots and leaves.
 The wood used to make the toys is soft in nature and the art of toy making is also known as Turned wood Lacquer craft.

Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA), 2010

Why in news?

- The Foreigners' Division of the Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has granted the FCRA license to Sri Sarada Peetham, an Andhra Pradesh-based institution, allowing it to receive donations and funding from foreign sources.
- The Peetham was founded with the mission to promote and propagate Sanatana Vaidik Dharma and Advaita Vedanta, following the traditions of Adi Shankaracharya.
- It serves as a centre for spiritual development, Vedic wisdom, and meditation.

Key Points:

- It is a law enacted by Parliament to regulate foreign contributions (especially monetary donations) provided by certain individuals or associations to NGOs and others within India.
- The Act, in its consolidating form, was originally passed in 1976 and majorly modified in 2010.

	 which aims to lower electricity bills and promote solar energy. Key Points: It is a government scheme launched on February 15, 2024, that aims to provide free electricity to households in India. Under the scheme, households will be provided with a subsidy to install solar panels on their roofs. The subsidy will cover up to 40% of the cost of the solar panels. Eligibility: The household must be an Indian citizen. The household must own a house with a roof that is suitable for installing solar panels. The household must have a valid electricity connection. The household must not have availed any other subsidy for solar panels.
Species in news: Olive Ridley Turtles	Why in news? The mystery surrounding the mass mortality of Olive Ridley turtles is becoming more complex, with Andhra Pradesh reporting 3,000 deaths. The main cause appears to be drowning, raising concerns about harmful fishing methods such as bottom trawling.
