Dhimsa Dance	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Residents of Buriga and China Konela, two isolated tribal villages in Ananthagiri mandal, celebrated a historic moment as electric street lights were installed, nearly 78 years after Independence.</li> <li>Both young and old joined in a traditional 'Dhimsa' dance, expressing their joy and gratitude for overcoming years of hardship without electricity.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dhimsa is a tribal dance form that is performed primarily by <b>Porja caste women in Andhra Pradesh</b>.</li> <li>Dhimsa <b>originated in Koraput district in the Odisha State</b>, but has almost become an official dance of Visakhapatnam.</li> <li>Andhra Pradesh's tribal dance is usually executed by roughly 15-20 women, even though both men and ladies of any age can participate.</li> <li>The Dhimsa dance is accompanied by instruments such as the Mori, Kiridi, Tudumu, Dappu, and Jodukommu.</li> </ul>
Annadata Sukhibhava scheme	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The State government will soon credit ₹20,000 into the accounts of each farmer in the State as financial aid under the Annadata Sukhibhava scheme, which includes ₹6,000 from the Centre's Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi minimum income support.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Annadata Sukhibhava Scheme is a welfare program for farmers in Andhra Pradesh.</li> <li>Provides financial assistance to farmers, Improves crop productivity, Provides immediate assistance to farmer families, and Extends additional benefits to farmer families covered under PM-KISAN.</li> </ul> <p><b>About PM KISAN:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-Kisan) Yojana came into effect from December 1, 2018.</li> <li>Under the scheme, income support of Rs 6000 per annum is provided to all eligible farmer families across the country in three equal installments of Rs 2,000 each every four months.</li> <li>The fund of Rs 2,000 is directly transferred to the bank accounts of the eligible farmers/farmer's family under the Direct Benefit Transfer Mode.</li> </ul>

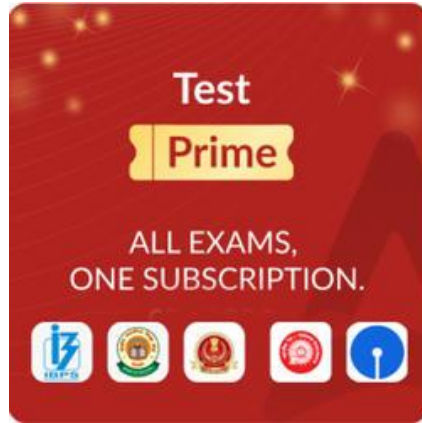
