UDISE	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>In Telangana, Aadhaar is required for student enrollment in the Unified District Information System for Education and to complete the Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry. Additionally, obtaining an Aadhaar card necessitates having a date of birth certificate.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>UDISE was initiated in 2012-13 by the Ministry of Education by integrating UDISE for elementary education and SEMIS for secondary education.</li> <li>Unified District Information on School Education (UDISE) is one of the largest Management Information Systems on school education.</li> <li>Purpose: It helps measure the education parameters from classes 1 to 12 in government and private schools across India.</li> <li>UDISE+ is an updated and improved version of UDISE.</li> <li>It was developed in the year 2018-19 to speed up data entry, reduce errors, improve data quality and ease its verification.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>



public. **Key Points:** The new Act has provision for creation of Bhudhar, record for all land parcels across the State and issuance of Bhudhaar cards for protecting the ownership rights as well as ensuring access to the land details with a click of mouse. This bill aims to amend the existing Record of Rights (RoR act) Act, replacing the outdated Dharani portal with the innovative Bhumata portal as an online platform to improve land registration process. Bhudhaar" means the land parcel unique identification number assigned to any parcel of land, as contained in the Record of Rights, in such manner as may be prescribed which includes -• "Temporary Bhudhaar" - a Bhudhaar assigned to indicate that the Geo-referencing of the parcel of land or lands appurtenant to the property has not been completed. "Permanent Bhudhaar" - a Bhudhaar assigned to 0 indicate that the Geo-referencing of the parcel of land or lands appurtenant to the property has been completed. Bhudhaar Card" means a document prepared or generated and maintained in an electronic form in such format as may be prescribed describing a parcel or parcels of land as contained in the Record of Rights, and specifying the Bhudhaar Number or Numbers assigned to such parcel or parcels. Aarogyasri Scheme Why in news? Deputy CM and Finance Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka • assured that sufficient funds will be allocated for the Aarogyasri scheme in the 2025-26 Budget, emphasizing the government's priority on the health sector. Key Points: The objective of the scheme is to improve access of BPL families to quality medical care for treatment of identified diseases involving hospitalization, surgeries and therapies through an identified network of health care providers. The entire premium is paid by the Government on behalf of the BPL families. The beneficiaries of the scheme are the **members of Below** Poverty Line (BPL) families as enumerated and photographed in BPL Ration Card and available in the Civil Supplies Department database.

	Key Points:

- He was the founder of the Maratha Empire in western India.
- He was born on February 19, 1630, to Shahaji Bhosle and Jijabai in the fort of Shivneri, near the city of Junnar in the Pune district, Maharashtra.
- With his valor and great administrative skills, Shivaji carved out an enclave from the declining Adilshahi sultanate of Bijapur. It eventually became the genesis of the Maratha Empire.
- He was known as the Father of the Indian Navy. Shivaji was the first to realise the importance of having a naval force.
- He was called the 'Mountain Rat' and was widely known for his guerrilla warfare tactics.
