	 Key Points: As part of phase one, 161 citizens' services are now available under Mana Mitra, which has been launched in collaboration with Meta. This initiative, in partnership with Meta, makes accessing government services as simple as chatting with a friend or family member. The services will cover six key categories: electricity bill payments, revenue services, municipal services, grievance redressal, and booking for temple darshan/seva and bus tickets. Key Points: Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) is a monetary measure of the total value of all goods and services produced within a state's boundaries over a specific period of time. It's a key indicator of a state's economic growth and is also known as State Income. It is compiled by the National Statistical Office (NSO). GSDP is usually calculated annually, but can also be calculated quarterly, monthly, or half-yearly. Learn more about Per Capita income (PCI): Per capita income (PCI) is a measure of the average income earned per person in a given area over a set period of time, such as a year. PCI = Total Income / Population
Blue Flag Certification	 Why in news? Recently, the Andhra Pradesh government has temporarily revoked the Blue Flag certification for Rushikonda Beach and relieved two officials of their duties.
