<p><b>Lankamala Sanctuary</b></p> <p><b>Wildlife</b></p>	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An ASI team has discovered a 16th-century Shaivite site in the Lankamala Wildlife Sanctuary.</li> <li>• The findings, spanning from the 4th to the 16th century CE, suggest that Lankamala was an important Shaivite pilgrimage center frequented by North Indian devotees.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is located in the Kadapa district of Andhra Pradesh.</li> <li>• Rivers: The Sanctuary forms the catchment for river Pennar. The Telugu ganga canal flows into the eastern flank of the Sanctuary draining into the 'Pennar river'.</li> <li>• Vegetation of Lankamalleswara Wildlife Sanctuary: It consists of Southern tropical dry deciduous forest in the hills, scrub forest in the plains, Southern dry mixed deciduous forest, Tropical thorn forests and Tropical dry evergreen forest.</li> </ul>

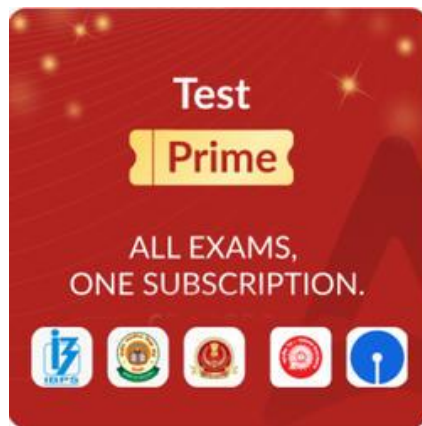
