<p>Public-Private-People Partnership" (P4) system</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chandrababu Naidu announces that the "Zero Poverty – P4" program will be launched on Ugadi, with the government creating a platform to allow the wealthy to support the underprivileged. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A "Public-Private-People Partnership" (P4) system is an expanded version of the traditional Public-Private Partnership (PPP). In this model: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Public sector (government) and private companies collaborate, as in a PPP. However, it also actively involves the local community or citizens ("people"). The community participates in the planning, development, and management of projects or services. The goal is to promote greater inclusivity and community ownership in both decision-making and the distribution of benefits.
<p>Srisailam Temple</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Srisailam temple administration has made all arrangements for the smooth conduct of the five-day Ugadi Mahotsavams starting March 27. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Srisailam Temple, or Sri Bhramaramba Mallikarjuna Swamy Temple, is a Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, worshipped here in the form of Mallikarjuna Swamy. It is surrounded by the forests of the Nallamala Hills, overlooking the pristine waters of the Krishna River. This ancient temple built in the Dravidian style with lofty towers and sprawling courtyards is one of the finest specimens of Vijayanagara architecture. Though the exact origins of the temple are not available, the Satavahanas of the 2nd century AD have referred to it. The unique feature of this temple is the combination of Jyothirlingam and Mahasakthi (in the form of Bhramarambika) in one campus, which is very rare and only one of its kind.

- It is on the southern banks of the Krishna river in Guntur district and is a recently constructed planned city after the Andhra Pradesh split.

Tuberculosis (TB)

Why in news?

- Concerted efforts are being made to make NTR district tuberculosis-free. Steps are being taken to identify people with the symptoms and raise awareness among the public.

Key Points:

- Tuberculosis (TB) is a **bacterial infection spread through inhaling tiny droplets from the coughs or sneezes of an infected person**.
- It mainly affects the lungs, but it can affect any part of the body, including the tummy (abdomen), glands, bones and nervous system.
- India's National TB Elimination Programme is strengthened to meet the goal of ending the TB epidemic by 2025 from the country, five years ahead of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) for 2030.
- The **National Strategic Plan for Tuberculosis Elimination(2017-2025)** was developed to achieve the goal.
- Though the National Strategic Plan for Tuberculosis Elimination (2017-2025) outlined a paradigm shift in approach and strategy to achieve the ambitious goal, by 2020, it became clear that the NSP will not be able to meet these objectives.
- A new **National Strategic Plan for Tuberculosis Elimination (2020-2025)** to end TB was launched.

Real Time Governance Society (RTGS)

Why in news?

- Chief Secretary K. Vijayanand instructed officials to speed up the data integration of RTGS for the quick rollout of the data lake initiative and to enhance WhatsApp Governance for easier access to government services.

Key Points:

- Real Time Governance Society (RTGS) is an **Indian e-governance initiative of chief minister N. Chandrababu Naidu**.
- The idea is to use **electronic communication and technology to deploy e-governance** in Andhra Pradesh.
- Data from **Andhra Pradesh Weather Forecasting and Early Warning Research Center, drones, machine learning systems, biometric systems and other surveillance systems** are collated and reported through the RTGS system in real-time.
