Non-Performing Assets (NPAs)	 Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman stated that non-performing assets (NPAs) of banks have reached a multi-year low due to government measures. Key Points: A NPA is a loan or advance for which the principal or interest payment remained overdue for a period of 90 days. Classification of assets: As per the RBI guideline, banks are required to classify NPAs further into - Substandard assets: Assets which have remained NPA for a period less than or equal to 12 months. Doubtful assets: An asset that has remained in the substandard category for a period of 12 months. Loss assets: It is considered uncollectible and of such little value that its continuance as a bankable asset is not warranted, although there may be some recovery value.
Tejas Mk1A	 Why in news? GE Aerospace will supply jet engines for the Tejas LCA-Mk1A. Key Points: It is a 4.5-generation single-seat supersonic multirole fighter aircraft. It is India's second indigenous fighter jet after the HAL HF-24 Marut. It is designed for offensive air support, close combat, and ground attack roles. It has three production models: Tejas Mark 1, Mark 1A, and trainer variant. Features: It is the smallest and lightest in its class of contemporary supersonic combat aircraft. It features a fin but lacks a horizontal tail. The aircraft weighs approximately 5,450 kg and has a maximum take-off weight of 13,500 kg. It is powered by a single-uprated General Electric F404-GE-IN20 engine. It is designed to carry a range of air-to-air,

Public Accounts Committee (PAC)	Why in news? ■ Aiming for a simplified Goods and Services Tax (GST) system, Parliament's Public Accounts Committee (PAC) has suggested that the Finance Ministry conduct a thorough review of the GST framework to identify and eliminate unnecessary procedures and requirements that complicate compliance.
	 Key Points: Established in 1921 (oldest parliamentary committee in India). Purpose: Audits the revenue and expenditure of the Government of India to ensure public funds are spent efficiently and legally. Key functions:
	 Examines the CAG audit report on government expenditure. Ensures money sanctioned by Parliament is spent properly. Investigates financial irregularities, losses, and inefficiencies in government spending. Membership: 22 members (15 from Lok Sabha, 7 from Rajya Sabha). Chairperson: A Lok Sabha MP, traditionally from the Opposition. Term: One year. Ministers cannot be members of the PAC.
PM Matru Vandana Yojana	Why in news? • Sonia Gandhi has stated that the scheme for pregnant women is severely underfunded.
	 Key Points: It is a Centrally Sponsored Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme launched in 2017. Objectives Providing partial compensation for the wage loss in terms of cash incentive, so that the woman can take adequate rest before and after delivery of the first child To improve health-seeking behaviour amongst Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers (PW&LM). Features of the Scheme: Provides maternity benefits to women from socially and economically disadvantaged sections. Benefit applies to the first two living children, with the second child being a girl. It is a Central to the second provided in the second child being a girl.

- Corals are essentially animals, which are sessile, meaning they permanently attach themselves to the ocean floor.
- Corals share a symbiotic relationship with single-celled algae called zooxanthellae.
- The algae provide the coral with food and nutrients, which they make through photosynthesis, using the sun's light.
- They use their tiny tentacle-like hands to catch food from the water and sweep into their mouth.
- Each individual coral animal is known as a polyp and it lives in groups of hundreds to thousands of genetically identical polyps that form a 'colony'.
- Corals are largely classified as either hard coral or soft coral. It is the hard corals that are the architects of coral reefs — complex three-dimensional structures built up over thousands of years.

What is Coral Bleaching?

- It happens when corals experience stress in their environment due to changes in temperature, pollution or high levels of ocean acidity.
- Under stressed conditions, the zooxanthellae or food-producing algae living inside coral polyps start producing reactive oxygen species, which are not beneficial to the corals.
